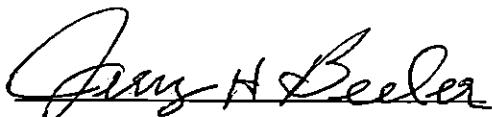
Fire Department: The Fire Department had nothing to report.
